Why this meeting:

There are currently a number of food and vet topics in circulation, and several groups are positioning for the upcoming calls in 2016-17.

The meeting will be used in part to map the funding opportunities through different instruments, and partly to interact with professional support companies to learn useful tips and tricks. Finally, experience from past proposals will be exchanged to improve future proposals.

Many groups are positioning for the coming calls, which is why small satellite meetings could be organized before, after, or in parallel with the main meeting.

- 1. Mapping the funding opportunities through different instruments, e.g. Industrial Leadership, Marie Curie, Research & Innovation Actions (RIA), etc.
- 2. Interaction with professional service companies to learn useful tips and tricks.
- 3. Exchange of experience from previous proposals.
- 4. Establishment of new consortia.
- 5. Consolidation and expansion of current consortia.
- 6. Satellite meetings to generate ideas for the ongoing initiatives.
