# Rules for Extra-mural studies Clinic for Ruminants and Swine

## 1. Scope of this directive:

### "Extra-mural studies at the Clinic for Ruminants and Swine"

#### 2. Course of action:

- (1) It starts at the first working day of a week at 07.30 a.m. followed by an instruction on the hygiene and safety plans of the clinic and the assignment of a locker.
- (2) Work starts at 07:30 a.m. and ends at 04:30 p.m.
- (3) Place: Clinic for Ruminants and Swine and farms.
- (4) Minimum length is 4 weeks.

## 3. Criteria for placing the Extra-mural studies:

- (1) Knowledge, skills and competence to be acquired: reliable knowledge and practical experience in dealing with ruminants and swine, ability to work independently after instruction within a team, perform the clinical examination, reliable anatomical and physiological knowledge of ruminants and swine, ability to assist in surgical treatments (operations, etc.), administer drugs (under supervision), reliable knowledge of German and/or Englisch to communicate with staff.
- (2) Registration has to be made by the online form on the website of the clinic with all necessary attachments (covering letter, CV) 6 months in advance at the minimum.

## 4. Requirements for getting the certificate:

Required is the regular and successful participation.

- (1) Presence must be acknowledged by signing a list during the time. A successful participation is given if the number of hours or days set in the regulations for the period is reached and the filled log sheets forms are provided to the responsible staff.
- (2) The certificate will be made by the end of the period under submission of the signed list, log sheet forms and the provided overall to the clinic office.

## 5. Further regulations:

- (1) The participants have to provide clean protective clothing (apron, rubber safety boots, etc.) and instruments for clinical examination. The clinic provides an overall. Please note the current hygiene standards of the clinic.
- (2) The number of participants is limited to two students during the Clinical Rotation, otherwise to three students.
- (3) The participants are responsible for insurance, housing and food.
